Third party vendors are an extension of your business, and in turn, your risk. Understanding and managing your risk from vendors in your supply chain is critical to your overall security posture.

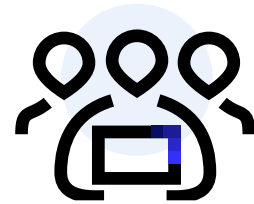
