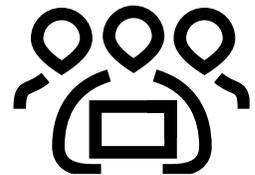
Ensure CMMC Compliance

Commercial organizations doing business (directly or indirectly) with the U.S. Department of War (DoW) are required to hold a Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) as a condition of contract award. GuidePoint Security CMMC services help organizations determine if CMMC applies and identify and remediate gaps to achieve compliance.

Since 2018, the DoW has required contractors to be NIST SP 800-171-compliant based on a self-service review. However, many prime and sub-contractors handling Federal Contract Information (FCI) and/or Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) still cannot fully account for FCI and/or CUI they store, process, transmit, or generate, or have access to as a subcontractor. Now, the DoW can discretionally require entities to achieve CMMC compliance as a condition of contract award, effectively adding a third-party certification and attestation layer to a previously self-attestation scenario. Organizations impacted include:

- ✓ Those who process, store or transmit FCI or CUI
- ✓ Those who provide security protections for any assets processing, storing or transmitting FCI or CUI
- ✓ Those who provide or manage platform infrastructure, applications or storage services for those organizations (e.g., ESPs, CSPs)
